nvironmental sustainability
played an integral role in the
design of this custom-built
Bayswater home, right down to
the use of low-toxicity paint.
The home is so well insulated that at
the peak of Perth's scorching summer,
the owner has rarely needed to turn on
the air-conditioning.
While the need to look after the planet
was an important factor in building a
sustainable home, the owner also wanted
a home she could afford to live in.
The most recent electricity bill for the
two-storey home was just \$65, thanks to
the use of a solar photovoltaic system.
The property also includes doubleglazed windows and a rainwater tank.
Builder Gary Wright, of Wright Homes,
said the introduction of a rainwater
system and the photovoltaic system on
the roof had considerably reduced





energy and water consumption in the home.

"Instead of walking into the home and turning on the air-conditioning to cool it down, she walks into an already cool house," he said.

"On top of that, we used waterwise tapware throughout the house."

In keeping with her energy-efficient home, the owner has also established a vegetable garden, which supplies her with most of her fruit and vegetables.

To ensure the vegetables are as organic as possible, the owner uses reverse osmosis water and no pesticides.

While the home is sustainable, it doesn't compromise on style.

The open-plan upstairs living and kitchen area, with its neutral tones and subtle splashes of red, provides the perfect place for the owner to relax.

The area opens up to a spacious balcony with panoramic Swan River and park views.

The three-bedroom, two-bathroom home includes a piano lounge and a security system with cameras.

The owner said despite the home being on a narrow 364sqm block, it felt open and spacious.
